Instructions for using the certified wireless access service with Android operating system "eduroam"

Necessary condition to connect to the wireless network "eduroam" is the existence of an account in the directory service of University of Crete (username@uoc.gr or username@DEPARTMENT.uoc.gr).

Android 10 – Connecting to the Wi-Fi network -> " eduroam "

2. Open "Network & internet" with the Wi-Fi icon



3. Turn on Wi-Fi use.



4. From the displayed networks, **select** to connect to the Wi-Fi network -> " eduroam "

 - 4 -> username (username in the format username@uoc.gr)

 - 6 -> **CONNECT**
