


Instructions for using the certified wireless access service with Android operating system “ eduroam ”

Necessary condition to connect to the wireless network “eduroam” is the existence of an account in the directory service of University of Crete (username@uoc.gr or username@DEPARTMENT.uoc.gr).

Android 10 – Connecting to the Wi-Fi network -> “ eduroam ”


1. Open the settings




2. Open “Network & internet” with the Wi-Fi icon



3. Turn on **Wi-Fi** use.



4. From the displayed networks, **select** to connect to the Wi-Fi network -> “ **eduroam** ”



5. In the following certification window select:

1 -> **PEAP**

2 -> **MSCHAPV2**

3 -> **Do not validate**

4 & 5 -> **Enter the information you have in the directory service**

4 -> **username** (username in the format username@uoc.gr)

5 -> **password** (password)

6 -> **CONNECT**
